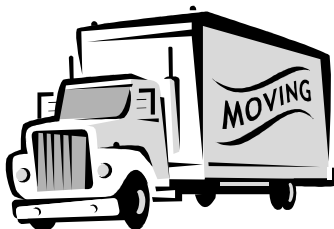


On the weekends of August 27-28 and September 10-11, your Parish Council will be asking you some questions.

Here's what you need:

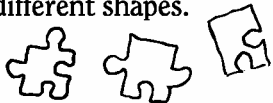
A postcard or picture from your summer adventures

Here's how to make it:

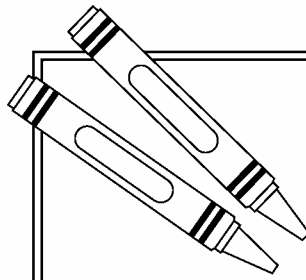
1. Cut your postcard or picture into 8 or 10 pieces of different shapes.
