### Weekend Liturgy Ministry

#### Music Ministries Adult Choir

The primary ministry of our Choir is to support the singing of all those present at liturgical celebrations and to encourage active participation of the assembly. A choir enhances the song of the assembly through harmonies, descants, and musical pieces appropriate for mass and the liturgical season. Our choir ministers at the 10:30 AM Sunday Mass each week as well as sacramental liturgies and celebrations including Confirmation, First Communion, Christmas, Holy Week, and Easter. A commitment to the choir includes weekly rehearsals on Thursdays from 7:00 – 8:30 PM, ministering at the 10:30 mass, and at other celebrations as determined by the Music Director or Pastor.

#### Instrumentalists/Musicians

Accompanists and solo instruments are needed to assist at various liturgies. If you have talent and experience with an instrument and are willing to share your gifts please let us know. This can be a small or large commitment on your part. We need piano, guitar, percussion, flute, violin, brass, keyboard any stringed or woodwind instrument. Rehearsal date and time is arranged between the Instrumentalist(s) and the Cantor/vocalists they are accompanying. Time commitment for Instrumentalists is approximately 2 hours between the rehearsal and the Mass.

#### Cantor Ministry

The Cantor’s calling is to drink deeply of God’s Word in order to share that Word by drawing others into common sung prayer and praise. Hence, proclaiming the Psalm and leading the assembly’s sung prayer is an important ministry in the church. Skills needed by the Cantor include those of public speaking; a basic knowledge of music; good diction, projection, and vocal techniques; and proper use of gesture within the liturgy. Musical and personal-prayerful preparation for liturgies is essential to the role of Cantor. The formation process includes training, and regular rehearsals as arranged with the Music Director, Accompanist, or Choir. Time commitment for Cantors is approximately 2 hours between the rehearsal and the Mass.

#### Music Ministry for Youth

Music is a vital part of youth formation. Children sing during Christian Formation on Wednesday’s and Sunday’s, sing at Vacation Bible School, and sing at their Christmas Programs. Our youth also participate in music through choir chimes, playing instruments for mass, and playing and singing for other youth events. Our young musicians need the help of Music Mentors and Assistants in learning instrumental music, the songs they sing, and in supervision. Youth involved in hand chimes and children’s choir typically rehearse on Wednesdays for 1 hour after Religious Education, or as determined by the Director. Time commitment includes the 1 hour rehearsals and playing for Mass or special events as determined by the Director.

Next weekend, at all masses, Reverend Mariadas Chatla will be speaking about the needs of the Diocese of Guntur, India, located on the east coast of the Bay of Bengal. Of the 5 million people who live in the diocese there are 190,000 Catholics. There are 79 parishes with 500 mission stations, being served by 110 diocesan priests, 60 religious priests and about 500 religious sisters.

The Diocese of Guntur is looking for help to support the education of the children. The literacy rate is 35%, with many of the children having no opportunity for a primary level education. Many of the people do not have homes or the homes have been destroyed by hurricanes. If they are able they work on farms for a pay of \$1.00 day.

A second collection will be taken up for the missions of the Diocese of Guntur. Your donations will help the Diocese of Guntur in educating the children, building homes and chapels, and fostering vocations to the Priesthood and Religious life.
