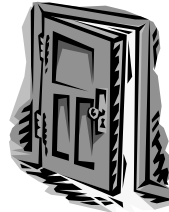

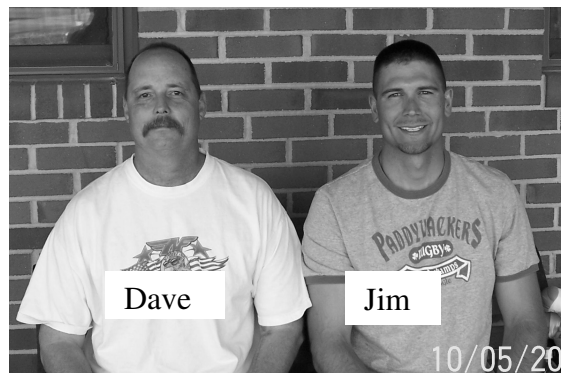

ACOLYTE (SERVER)



Acolytes

Acolytes assist the presider during the Mass by holding the Sacramentary, helping at the presentation of the gifts and carrying the cross or candles. To be an acolyte, you must have received First Communion. You must have the ability to be attentive and reverent during Mass. You must be dependable. Training and guidance are provided. Acolytes are scheduled on a rotating basis with most Acolytes scheduled at least two to three times in a two month period.

MASS COORDINATOR

Mass Coordinators are asked to arrive 20 to 30 minutes before Mass starts to insure that everything is in place for the celebration of the Mass. They assist the priest in making sure the Acolytes, Lectors and Eucharistic Ministers have arrived and are checked in. Mass Coordinators are asked to stay 10 to 15 minutes after Mass to insure that everything is put away properly and that everything is in place for the next Mass. Training is provided on an ongoing basis. The only skills needed are an attention to detail, a willingness to learn and a desire to be of service

This is not a survey!!

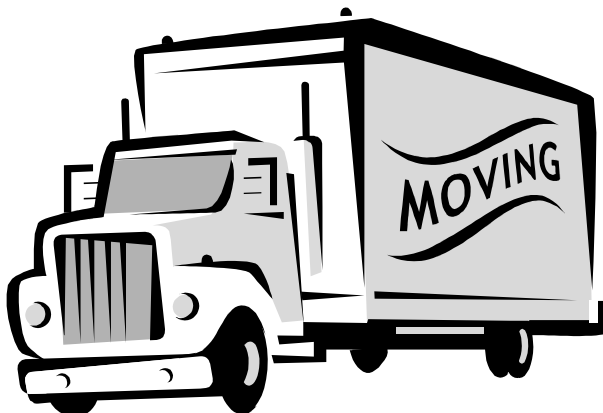
This is your chance to help shape the future of this faith community.
