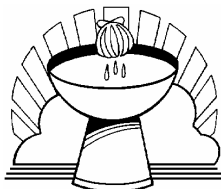

With the intentions of keeping all interested parishioners informed, I wish to summarize a recent recommendation by the Finance Council that will be presented to the Pastoral Council on June 22, 2005.

On, May 24, 2005, the Finance Council unanimously approved the recommendation to the Pastoral Council to pursue the purchase of a parcel of land that currently surrounds the four plus acres St. Jude's currently calls home. The Scott family, which generously donated the original property, has shown interest in selling additional contiguous property to Jude's. The parcel consists of 23.88 acres and basically is an "L" shape surrounding our current property from New City Road on the southeast around our current property to the Methodist Church. It is the hope of the Finance Council that a contract to purchase can be mutually agreed upon in the \$9,000 to \$10,000 per acre range; for a total of up to \$240,000. The Diocese is aware of our intention and would also provide the financing.

As you may already be aware, the Diocese through St. Jude's and St. Mary's in Pittsfield own approximately 500 acres in Rochester Township. Some of this land is being sold to Sangamon County for the Riverton/Rochester road project. The reality of our parish is that we are currently land locked at our present location. Any future expansion is hindered by our parcel size, thus expansion would mean relocation. Our present church structure remains adequate for our parish needs, but it is becoming increasingly evident that the parish center will need to be improved, expanded or replaced. It is the belief of the Finance Council that purchasing the Scott property would secure our future at the current site, and regardless of future expansion, would be less expensive than relocating a church, parish center and rectory.

The source of repayment will be the future sale and/or development of currently owned property, farm revenue although minimal, parishioner collections and parish fund raisers.

The Finance Council recommendation will be discussed and voted on at the Pastoral Council meeting scheduled for June 22, 2005. If interested, you may attend the Pastoral Council meeting which always is open to parishioners. All parishioners are invited and encouraged to attend a question and answer meeting scheduled for Wednesday, June 15, 2005 at 7:00PM in the Parish Center. In the interim, if anyone has specific questions or concerns, myself as well as all Finance Council members, will always make ourselves available for discussion.
