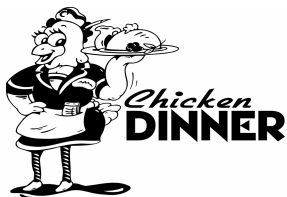
St. Jude's Awarded Grant

I am so pleased to announce to you that our parish is one of only 3 parishes in our Diocese chosen to participate in the Apollos Project sponsored by the Aquinas Institute of Theology in St. Louis, Missouri. The Lilly Endowment, Inc., a private foundation based in Indianapolis awarded Aquinas a 1.7 million dollar grant, which is the largest in its' history. It will fund an initiative to educate lay people about the state of the church today and their roles in sustaining it. The project strives to change behaviors among Catholics and make them active in determining the futures of their parishes.

The Apollos Project will enable our parish to establish a 5-year collaborative partnership with Aquinas Institute. By participating, our parish will serve as an incubator for a model of ministry in which pastors and professionally trained lay people form a team to meet the needs of their community. A member of our staff will be awarded a fellowship to pursue a graduate degree in theology which will enable them to be formed and educated in the Roman Catholic tradition as a ministerial leader within our parish.

As part of our partnership with Aquinas Institute of Theology through the Apollos Project, we will be participating in a parish survey. The results will provide Aquinas Institute with information regarding our attitudes about the priest shortage; parishioners' ideas about the future of leadership in the Catholic Church and the role of the laity. During the masses on the weekend of June 11-12, the survey will be distributed and completed during the usual time for the homily. Your participation is very important for the parish.
