Father Louis Querbes



Father Querbes (Curbs) is the founding father of the Clerics of St. Viator, of which Father Bill is a member. He was born on August 21, 1793 in the France. During his youth many churches and schools were destroyed and as he grew older he realized the need to rebuild the church. He focused his energies after being ordained a priest to liturgy and the religious education of youth. Father Querbes trained men to be teachers and sent them out to the surrounding parishes to establish religious education programs. St. Viator was chosen as the patron saint by Father Querbes because St. Viator had been a teacher and worked with youth. Today the work of both Father Querbes who died on September 1, 1859 are carried out by the Clerics of St. Viator in more than 11 countries including: Canada, France, Italy, Peru, Spain, Japan, Belize, Haiti, Columbia, Taiwan, Africa and the United States and of course right here at St. Judes.
