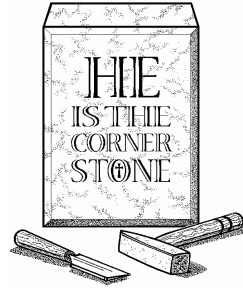

RCIA

The **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)** is a process for bringing into the Catholic Church both those who have never been baptized (Catechumens) and those who were baptized in a non-Catholic Church (Candidates for Full Communion). RCIA is also the best way for adult Catholics who have never been confirmed to prepare for that final Sacrament of Initiation.

The Church of St. Jude offers a year- round process that invites interested individuals and families to begin whenever they are able to do so. On **Tuesday February 21st at 6:30 pm**, the RCIA team will be offering an open Inquiry session. This is your opportunity to come and visit with some of the parishioners who work in the RCIA ministry. 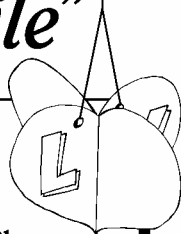

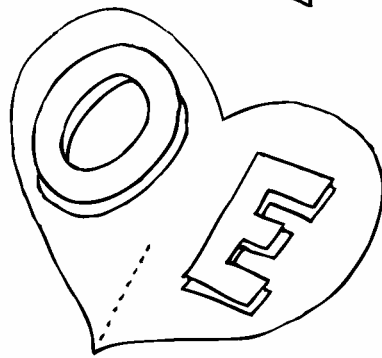
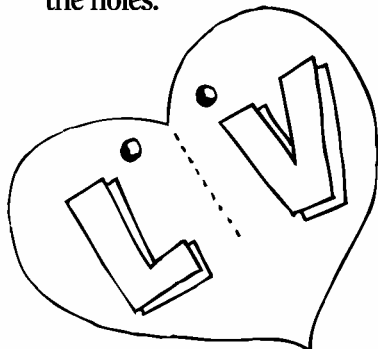
Make a heart "mobile"

- ♥ a piece of yarn or string




1. Cut out each heart.
