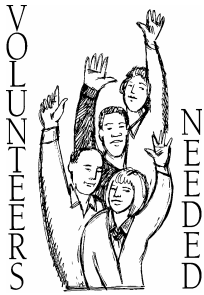

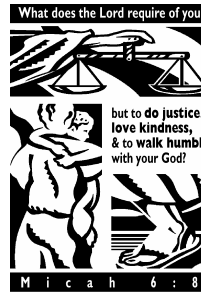

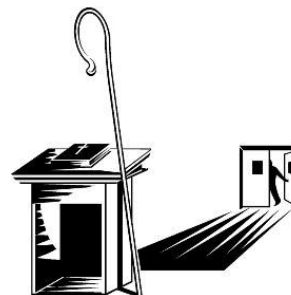
### Support More Food Aid for Haiti and African countries in crisis!

The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops is asking Catholics in Illinois to contact Senators Dick Durbin and Barack Obama NOW and urge them to retain assistance for Sudan, Liberia, Haiti, and the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) as well as Title II food aid that is currently in the FY 2006 supplemental appropriations bill as passed by the U.S. Senate Appropriations Committee. There is a serious threat to eliminate this aid from the final bill.
