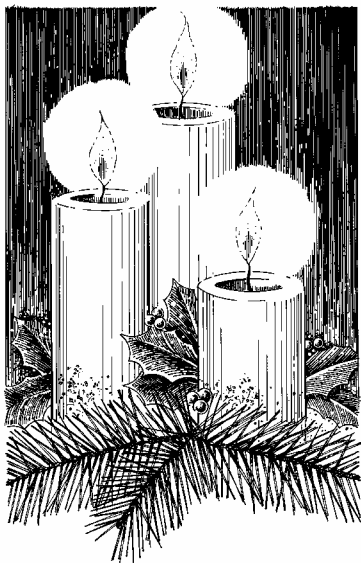


Thank you to everyone for purchasing bread on Breadline Sunday. We collected \$779.50 to benefit St. John’s Breadline.

CONFIRMATION

One of the three sacraments of Christian initiation celebrated in the church today, confirmation is celebrated in varying times and in as many ways as there are gifts of the Holy Spirit. Confirmation is celebrated, by some, during adolescence after some period of catechesis and service, by others when they come into full communion with the Catholic Church, by some at the age of reason before the celebration of First Holy Communion, and by still others when they are baptized. So many ways of celebrating the sacrament often create confusion. Many have heard the phrase "confirmation is a sacrament in search of a theology." Yet we can be certain that the sacrament celebrates the gift of the Holy Spirit we all receive in baptism and helps us to live as disciples of Christ.
