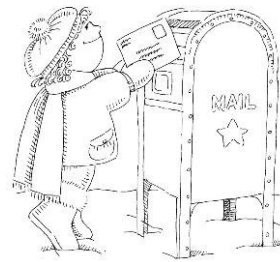
Friend's Program

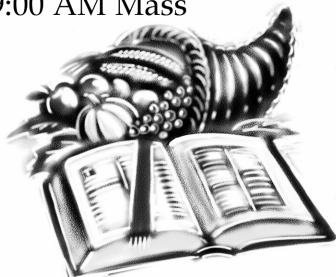

Hospitality Chairperson

Works in cooperation with Liturgy Chairperson and Pastor

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Six month experience as hospitality minister
- Friendly and outgoing manner
- Organizational and communication skills or willingness to develop these

TIME COMMITMENT:

2 hours per month

RESPONSIBILITY:

- To oversee the recruiting, training and maintenance of the hospitality ministry of the parish so that the assembly feels a welcome part of the community.
- Serve as a liturgy committee member, functioning as a representative of hospitality ministers and as an active participant in the work of the liturgy committee

DUTIES:

- Recruit additional/replacement persons to the hospitality ministry
- Provide initial training for hospitality ministers
- Provide ongoing training for hospitality ministers
- Affirm and support hospitality ministers in their ministry
- Communicate as necessary with other parish chairpersons and staff
- Serve on the liturgy committee
- Act as a liaison between hospitality ministers and liturgy committee
