Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed
All Soul's Day
Mass – 5:45pm

On All Soul's Day we remember our friends and loved ones who have left this world and who await entrance into God's presence. True remembrance is not just about looking back to the past but also looking ahead to the future in trust and hope. Just as our loved one shared in Christ's death in baptism, we believe that he or she will share in Christ's resurrection and enjoy eternal life in God's presence.

Have you lost a loved one recently?

This year we would like to invite those members of our community who have lost a loved one to join with other members of the community in remembering their loved one in a special way. During the 5:45pm Mass on November 2nd the name of each person we have been asked to remember will be placed on a candle, and as the family enters the church they will receive the unlit candle. During the service as the name of the loved one is announced, the family members and/or friends of the deceased will be asked to come forward and light the candle from the Paschal Candle, and then place it on the Commemoration Table by the Baptismal. After Mass, the candle may be taken home.

If you would like us to include your loved one in our Feast of All Souls remembrance, please call the parish office at 498-9524. This will allow us to prepare a candle for your loved one. We would then ask that you or a member of your family be present at the All Souls Day mass to receive and light the candle.
