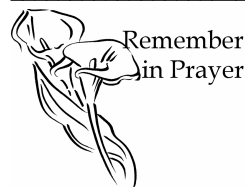

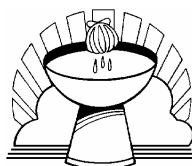

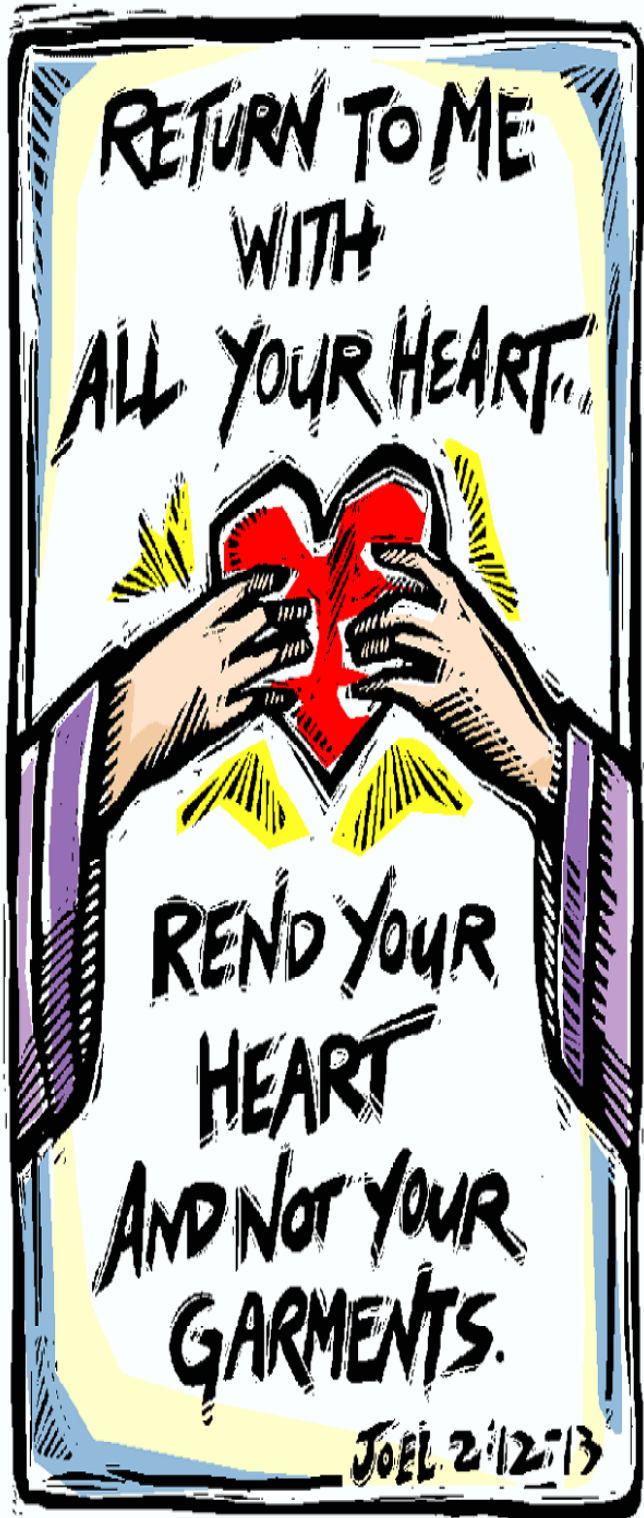
### Victim Assistance
