We are in need of Extraordinary Ministers of the Holy Communion for the 10:30am Masses on Sunday.

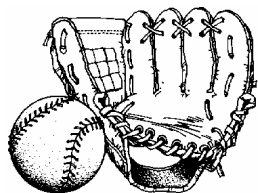

Sacrificial Giving

We place our offering in the basket located on the table behind the last row of chairs.

Three years ago we began offering parishioners the opportunity to make contributions to the Church using electronic fund transfers instead of using weekly envelopes. This opportunity still exists today. If you are interested, forms are located on the book rack at the entrance to church or you can stop by the parish office to pick up a form. You will need to complete the pertinent information of the form; choose the donation frequency (monthly or semi-monthly); the amount of the contribution and what funds the contribution should be credited to. After completion, attach a voided check or a savings deposit slip. It can then be placed in the collection basket or mailed to the office. If you have any questions about electronic contributions, please contact Sue Bozarth in the office.
