Both the first reading the today's Psalm say clearly that the Lord hears the cry of the poor. Have I been given the gifts – of time or money or abilities – to be the means by which God answers their need?

## OCTOBER 28: FEAST OF ST. JUDE

Our parish celebrates its patronal feast day today in the Feast of the Apostles Simon and Jude. We will honor him in prayer as we administer the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick and pray for his intercession. St. Jude Thaddeus was a kinsman (cousin) of Jesus; apparently, his mother was a cousin of Jesus' mother, Mary, and his father, Cleophas, was the brother of Joseph. St. Jude was a witness to Christ's death and resurrection. The Letter of Jude in the New Testament (Bible) is addressed to a Christian community struggling with persecution. St. Jude exhorts the community of believers to adhere to their faith in Christ in order to endure their seemingly hopeless struggle. St. Jude is the patron of hopeless cases; he is the one to whom we can turn for intercession when we despair or face seemingly impossible situations. A prayer card and St. Jude clip is available after Mass.
