Already baptized (at the hospital on day of birth), we will welcome Joseph with the ceremonial rites associated with baptism and present him with our donations of support.



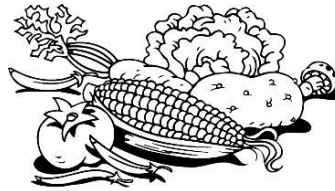

## Feast of the Assumption

(Holyday of Obligation)

**August 14<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m.**

**August 15<sup>th</sup> at 6:45 a.m.**

The Feast of the Assumption, a holyday of obligation, honoring Mary, mother of Jesus is August 15th. This feast commemorates two events - the "falling asleep" of the Blessed Virgin at the end of her life, and the assumption (the taking of her body) up to heaven.

Pope Pius XII, in 1950, defined that Mary "after the completion of her earthly life...was assumed body and soul into the glory of Heaven." Her body wasn't allowed to corrupt nor was it allowed to remain in a tomb. Though there are claims by some cities about possessing her temporary tomb.

In the early Christian centuries relics of saints and those who gave their lives for the faith were jealously guarded and highly prized. Many cities claim the mortal remains of saints, both famous and little known. But there are no records of Mary's bodily remains being venerated anywhere.

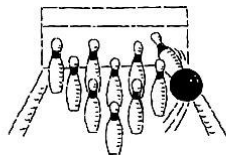
