The Mission Trip 2009 will be to **Denver, Colorado!**

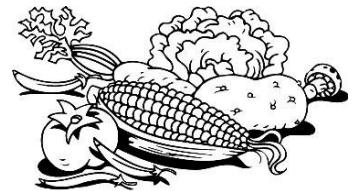
The first fundraiser will be a Chicken Dinner on Sunday, Sept. 7, beginning at 11:30.
