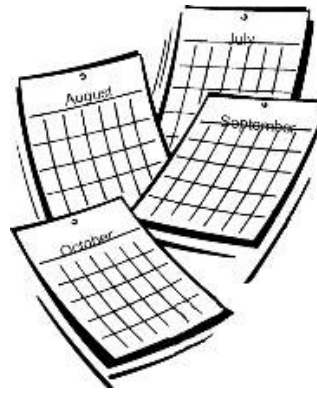


St. Jude's Co-ed Softball Team will play this Sunday, July 13 at 1:45p.m. on diamond #3 at the Rochester Park.
