St. Jude's Lenten Communal Penance Service March 6th at 6:30 p.m.

The Communal Penance Service is an opportune time for Returning Home to the Lord for Lent by repenting of our sins and believing in the words of the Gospel: God is kind and merciful, rich in compassion, and abiding in love. Please take the opportunity to be reconciled with God and the Church.
