Church Dusters for the week of May 26th are Sue and Victoria Arnish and Carla Houser.

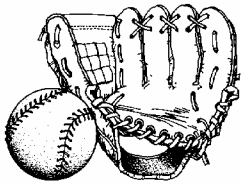
