Weather permitting, we will begin that liturgy under the portico of the parish center. The other two Masses (the 5:30 pm Vigil on Saturday and the 10:30 am Sunday Mass) will follow the rubrics for Mass with the simple entrance and blessing of palms in the foyer of the Church.
