

Notes from
Fr. Dean



Following weeks of Lent/Easter and Special Feast Days of Holy Trinity and Corpus Christi, the weekend Scriptures continue with the Counting of the Sundays, considered Ordinary Time. It is taken from the Latin word, *Ordinal*, which means counted. The weeks are not ordinary, but a counting of the weeks until the 34th and final week of the Liturgical Year, known as Christ the King Sunday. Each Sunday is a celebration of the Lord's Death and Resurrection, which is not an ordinary event.

Perhaps you might have realized that we skipped a week in the ordinary time! The weeks are counted from the feast of the Baptism of the Lord and the counting is interrupted for the Seasons of Lent/Easter and then resumed with the week of Pentecost. Due to the number of Sundays differing in each Calendar Year, the counting resumes with the number that will bring about the end of the Liturgical Year with the 34th week. Thus you have a piece of Liturgical trivia.
